The closest sessions to our association will be held at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville. (See the insert below for date, time and costs.)

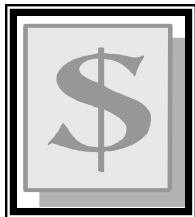
Conferences will be offered on these topics:

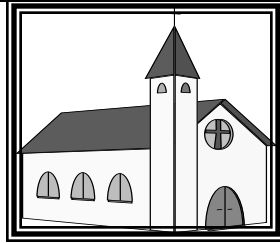

## Randy's Remarks...



Being an Acts 1:8 association involves us in many opportunities for ministries. Recently, the OTBA Baptist Builders went to Princeton, Kentucky to get a fellowship hall under roof for the Highland Baptist Church.

Rick Lucas gave the following report on the project: "...A first ever! We finished on Tuesday afternoon — 2 and 1/2 days early. ... a total of 47 persons took part, with an average per day of 31. Just the right size group for a project this size. ...We collected individual offerings of \$1,170 and gave an additional \$1,500 from our general fund as a gift to the church's building fund, for which they were extremely grateful. That offering will more than cover the cost of insulating the building. ...Rough wiring is completed and the plumber and HVAC company will begin their work soon. ...They (the church) have secured a bid from a drywall company that will buy, install and finish the drywall for \$200 more than they could buy, install it themselves and pay someone to finish it.

It looks like the fellowship hall is well on its way towards being ready for completion by a fall church homecoming!"

Lucas shared that the highlight of the trip and the whole project was hearing from the pastor that a lady came to faith in Jesus Christ! This is what mission trips and projects are all about: sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ in order that all may have opportunity to hear the message and come to know the only One who can forgive sin and give abundant life now and everlasting life with Him!
